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LUKOIL DEVELOPS COOPERATION WITH ARCELORMITTAL IN KAZAKHSTAN

LUKOIL has provided the first supplies of lubricants for the rolling mills of ArcelorMittal Temirtau, the leader of Kazakhstan's mining and metals sector.

According to the agreement, ArcelorMittal's plants in Kazakhstan will use LUKOIL INTEGO (ISO VG 220 and 460) oil for servicing industrial equipment. In the nearest future, LUKOIL is also going to supply the partner with hydraulic and gear oils.
